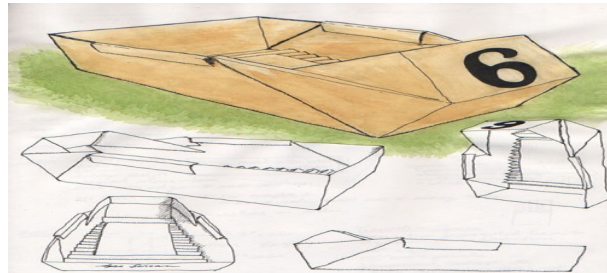

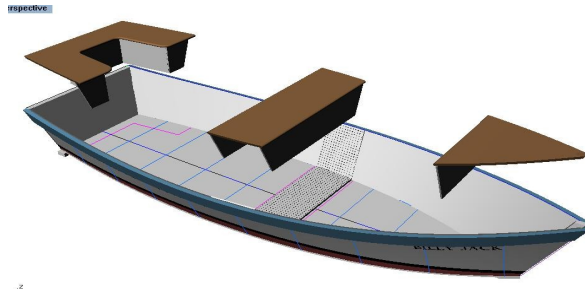

## *Cardboard Boat Race to Benefit Sevier County United Way*

### Race Rules and Regulations

#### **Construction**

1. Boat hull and seating must be constructed of corrugated cardboard. No limit on thickness.
2. Duct tape and other tape products can be used but cannot cover entire craft.
3. Paints, plastic wraps, waxes, and resins cannot be used.
4. Non-toxic, water based glues can be used to laminate layers of cardboard, but cannot cover hull.
5. Outriggers, masts, stacks, sails, and other decorative attachments can be made with materials other than cardboard as long as it does not create a safety issue (no sharp objects or metals).
6. Boats must be easy to enter and exit in the event of sinking or capsizing
7. Paddles and oars can be constructed of cardboard or canoe/kayak paddles may be used.
8. Dimensions: boats cannot be more than 6 feet wide and 14 feet long, 10 feet long for a single racer.
9. Boats that do not pass inspection may still be able to participate but will be disqualified from winning, unless disqualification was made for safety reasons.
10. No profane or offensive design or decorations may be used.

#### **Rules**

1. Crew and any in-water participants must be able to swim or wear a U.S. Coast-guard approved life jacket.
2. Racers can receive help entering boat but no push-offs from wall will be allowed.
3. Racers are also prohibited from using side walls or lane ropes to provide forward motion.
4. Participants must remove boats and any remnants of it after the race.
5. Lifeguards may stop the race or activity for any reason with regards to safety of all participants.
